

## Hiding a Group from your profile

Did you know you can conceal the logo of a group of which you are a member from appearing on your profile? There may be all kinds of reasons why you might want to do this e.g. it's a recruitment focused group and you want to hide it from your boss, new area of interest and don't want to alarm your employer, just don't want to be bugged by recruiters looking for certain types of people, etc.

It can be altered by going into 'edit Profile' - see our visual below and follow the instructions below that:



- Move your cursor over **Profile** at the top of the homepage and select **Edit Profile**.
- Scroll down to the **Groups** box in your profile (probably right at the bottom) and click the Edit symbol (*little pencil*).
- Click the "See...more" link to expand the box and see all your groups if necessary.
- Click the link under the group in question. The link will either say **Visible** or **Hidden**. This will take you to the **Visibility Settings** section of the group's **Settings** page.
- Check or uncheck the box next to "Display the group logo on your profile".
- Click **Save Changes**.
- You're done!
